Installation Instructions

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Using an experienced installer is recommended when installing stone sinks.
- 2. Countertop materials vary and require different cutting methods. Please take this into consideration during installation.
- 3. Please follow all local plumbing and building codes.
- 4. Sinks are handmade with slight variations in size. Please use the actual sink when making the installation cutout.
- 5. Prior to installation, inspect sink for any damage.
- 6. To protect sink, keep in shipping box until final installation (only remove it to make installation cutout).
- 7. Santa Fe By Design not responsible for the sink or countertop if any damage occurs during installation.
- 8. After installation, clean the sink using a mild cleanser and a soft cloth. Do not use harsh cleaners, abrasive pads, or wire brushes. Please refer to the RA Magnus "Care & Maintenance" instructions for full details.

STONE VESSEL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place sink into desired position on countertop. Leave proper clearance for faucet, backsplash, and any accessories.
- 2. Mark drain opening on countertop. Opening will be 3" in diameter (drain size is 1.5" in diameter). NOTE: 1.5" is added to the diameter of the drain opening to determine countertop cutout.
- 3. Cut countertop opening.
- 4. Place sink into cutout to test fit. Make sure sink sits level within opening and drain is centered.
- 5. Clean and then dry countertop opening and underside of sink. Apply a bead of silicone adhesive caulk (not included) to countertop around the opening.
- 6. Insert sink into opening, keeping drain centered.
- 7. Install drain (according to manufacturer's instructions).
- 8. Remove excess caulking and allow adhesive to properly cure.

NOTE: Drain assembly, silicone adhesive caulk, and sink's weight will anchor Stone Vessel sink to countertop.
